The alternative route for pedestrians and vehicular traffic, in respect of the Highway, which is available for use during the period the Highway is restricted are the highways to the rear of 34 Fairways, to the side of 165, Victoria Road, to the front of 165 to 193, Victoria Road and to the side of 193, Victoria Road, as shown by the dotted lines on the plan annexed to this Order.


