

## 30 hours childcare funding for 3 & 4 year olds, for working parents – things to remember! www.childcarechoices.gov.uk

## Information for parents:

- Apply for the funding via <a href="www.childcarechoices.gov.uk">www.childcarechoices.gov.uk</a>, in the term of your child's 3rd birthday (see table below). You can apply before this, but we have found that parents have missed their <a href="reconfirmation date">\*reconfirmation date</a> (typically every three months) when applying very early, resulting in their code expiring before the child takes up the place.
- Take your 30 hours 11 digit code, national insurance number and child's date of birth, to your
  childcare provider as soon as you receive it so that this can be validated. This is important as it is a
  reminder to you and your childcare provider as to when you will need to go back into your online
  account to reconfirm your details.
- You will need to log back into your Childcare Choices (gateway) account every three months to reconfirm your details. If your details have not changed, you only need to tick a box to confirm that your details are the same.
  - \* Please ensure that you are in the 'Free Childcare for Working Parents' area and not

## Tax-Free Childcare.

- Validity periods (\*reconfirmation dates) will typically be three months. In certain circumstances, the length may vary. If a sibling has previously had the funding, HMRC may shorten the validity period so that it aligns with the older sibling's dates.
- **Set a reminder** on your mobile phone/device calendar to reconfirm your 30 hours code you can reconfirm up to four weeks before. If you miss this date, you are at risk of losing the funding!
- You should receive two reminders to reconfirm either by email or text message four weeks and two
  weeks before the deadline date that you will be given on application (check your spam / junk
  folders). It is your responsibility to check the date that you need to reconfirm, and make sure that
  you do this before the deadline.
- Children cannot take up or transfer a place whilst in their **grace period** if you are unsure what this is, please speak to your childcare provider.
- Parents are advised to contact HMRC on 0300 123 4097 if they have any problems creating a
  gateway account, applying for the funding or with any questions about the online application
  process.

If your child's third birthday falls between	Child becomes eligible for funded place
1st September – 31st December	Spring Term
* think about completing application around mid-October (valid code/application <i>DEADLINE</i> 31st December)	In the January after their third birthday
1st January – 31st March	Summer Term
* think about completing application around mid-January (valid code/application <i>DEADLINE</i> 31st March)	In the April after their third birthday
1st April – 31st August	Autumn Term
* think about completing application around mid-June (valid code/application <i>DEADLINE</i> 31st August)	In the September after their third birthday

the application times are to ensure that if eligibility is confirmed, your 11 digit code should take you into the next term, ensuring that your child can access a 30 hour place the term after their third birthday/after application.
