Where to look for accommodation

There are a number of different places to look for accommodation depending upon the type of accommodation that you wish to move into.

Renting from a Housing Association

Housing associations (also called Registered Providers) are not for profit organisations providing and managing homes for rent and sale.

There are a number of **housing associations** in the Bolton area with houses to rent. Many of these houses are available through the Homes for Bolton scheme. This scheme allows applicants to 'bid' for available properties of their own choice, based on their housing need. - a variety of types of homes available e.g. apartments, houses with gardens.
