Detail- This adoption statement gives notice that Bolton Council has resolved to adopt the Statement of Community Involvement on 27th July 2022

We undertook a review of our SCI during autumn 2021 and consulted on a revised draft to ensure it refers to up to date planning legislation and sets out clearly the Council's current processes for determining planning applications, including the current scheme of delegation. In addition, information on plan making at the Greater Manchester level has also been updated to refer clearly to production of the "Places for Everyone" Plan.

All comments received have now been considered.

The Statement of Community Involvement came into effect on 27th July 2022

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of this decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SCI was adopted
