

Update on Area Working Budgets for Brightmet Ward – 4th May 2023 – 31st March 2024

As at the 4th May 2023, the Area Working Discretionary Budget available to Brightmet ward was £59,303.58. This figure was calculated taking account of the ward boundary changes which applied from that date.

There was also had a Growing the Good Work Budget of £15,000 and a One-off budget allocation of £50,000.

Since then, the following schemes have been approved under the Council's Scheme of Delegation.
