

Update on Area Working Budgets for Westhoughton North and Hunger Hill – 4th May 2023 to 31st March 2024

As at the 4th May 2023, the Area Working Discretionary Budget available to Westhoughton North & Hunger Hill ward was £8,125.00 This figure was calculated taking account of the ward boundary changes which applied from that date.

There was also had a Growing the Good Work Budget of £15,000 and a One-off budget allocation of £50,000.
