COTTON DRIVE, BOLTON USRN: 3406682	From its junction with Beehive Road, for an approximate distance of 92.5 metres in a south-easterly and then south-westerly direction, to its turning-head end.	92.5 metres
LOOM CLOSE, BOLTON USRN: 3406683	From its junction with Beehive Road, for an approximate distance of 35.8 metres in a south-westerly direction, to its turning-head end.	35.8 metres
KEEPERS WALK, BOLTON USRN: 3406681	From its junction with Beehive Road, for an approximate distance of 104.6 metres in a south-westerly direction, to its junction with Crescent Road	104.6 metres

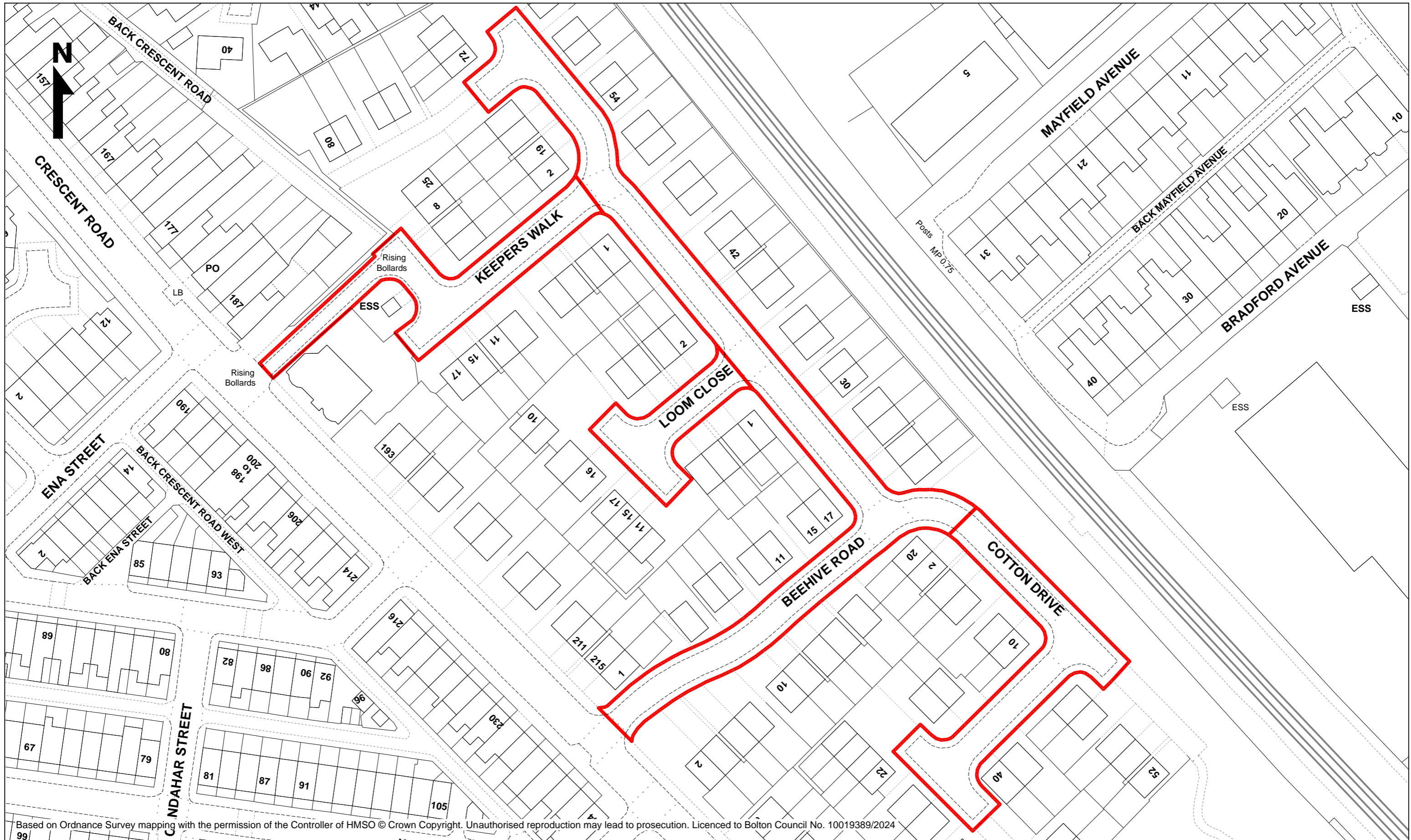
