

Update on Area Working Budgets for Westhoughton South Ward – 1st April 2024 – 30th June 2024

As at the 1st April 2024, the Area Working Discretionary Budget available to Westhoughton South was £11,903.27

There was also a Growing the Good Work Budget of £21,945 and a One-off budget allocation of £50,000.
