MARSDEN ROAD - TEMPORARY ONE-WAY TRAFFIC

The Council intends to make an order, operative from 19 January 2025 for 4 days approx, the effect of which will implement a one-way traffic restriction on Marsden Road from Deansgate to St Georges Rd (permitted direction northbound) to allow water works to take place. Alternative route is via St Georges Road, Kay Street, Manor Street, Bank Street, Bradshawgate, Great Moor Street, Ormrod Street, Moor Lane. The Order will end after 18 months or on completion of the works whichever first occurs.

- Signs must be placed in accordance with TSM and the scheme RAMS pack.
- Site conditions may have changed since the design of the drawing any changes which subsequently affect the design need to be reported by the Traffic Management Operative & any changes implemented must comply with Chapter 8.
